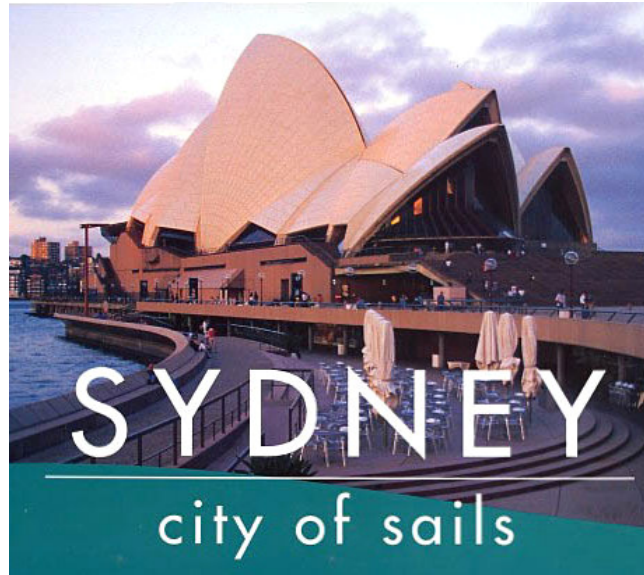


## LEARNING AND LIVING IN SYDNEY
